Answer Key

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1. Midnight snack. SNACK is parked in the middle of NIGHT, a snack at mid night.
2. Orange juice. The word JUICE printed in orange reads orange juice.
3. Feeling down. FEELING is printed so it reads downward, feeling down.
4. Big mood. The word MOOD printed huge is a big mood.
5. Second wind. Two copies of WIND with an arrow pointing at the second one, a second wind.
6. Red flag. The word FLAG is printed in red ink, so you read the color first: red flag.
7. Big shot. The word SHOT is drawn huge, so the size reads first: big shot.
8. First aid. Three copies of AID, and the arrow singles out the first one: first aid.
9. Think twice. The word THINK is printed two times, so you think twice.
10. Drain. TRAIN loses its T, takes a D, and goes down the DRAIN.
11. Great idea. GR8 is texting shorthand for GREAT, and the lightbulb is the classic symbol for an IDEA.
12. Atone. STONE minus S plus A is ATONE: to make up for something.
13. Sleeping on the job. SLEEPING sits directly on THE JOB, which reads as sleeping on the job.
14. Coast. TOAST drops the T, adds a C, and cruises down the COAST.
15. The last minute. The arrow points at the final MINUTE in the row, reading as the last minute.
16. While. SMILE without the S, plus a W, lasts a WHILE.
17. Sleep on it. SLEEP is resting on IT, so you sleep on it.
18. Wake up. WAKE is rotated to read upward, so it says wake up.
19. Rent. TENT swaps its first T for an R and now you owe RENT.
20. Top dog. The arrow singles out the TOP copy of DOG in the column: top dog.
21. Pitch. WITCH loses the W, gains a P, and throws a perfect PITCH.
22. Food for thought. FOOD 4 THOUGHT reads food for thought, with 4 sounding as for.
23. Handy. CANDY swaps C for H and turns HANDY.
24. Pie in the sky. PIE tucked inside the word SKY reads as PIE IN THE SKY.
25. Why me?. The letter Y sounds like WHY, followed by the literal word ME, the universal groan of the unlucky.
26. Anytime. The letter names N and E said together sound like ANY, followed by the literal word TIME.
27. Upside-down cake. The word CAKE is printed upside down: upside-down cake.
28. Dream big. The word DREAM printed huge reads as dream big.
29. Forever. Four EVERs read as 'four ever': forever.
30. Little brother. The word BROTHER printed tiny reads as 'little brother'.
31. Pin. One comma clips the S off SPIN and drops a PIN.

32. Hat. Swap the C in CAT for an H and the cat turns into a HAT.
33. Art. Two commas trim S and T from START: what is left is pure ART.
34. Stuck in traffic. STUCK is written inside TRAFFIC: stuck in traffic.
35. Luck. Pluck the P off PLUCK and you are in LUCK.
36. Thank you. TEN-Q said aloud sounds like 'thank you'.
37. Lip. The comma snips the C from CLIP and leaves a LIP.
38. Back in business. BACK sits inside BUSINESS: back in business.
39. Heat. One comma cuts the W from WHEAT and brings the HEAT.
40. Little finger. The word FINGER printed tiny: the LITTLE finger.
41. Bear. The trailing comma shaves the D off BEARD: out walks a BEAR.
42. Big deal. The word DEAL written extra large: a BIG deal.
43. Plum. Cut the final P off PLUMP and it slims down to a PLUM.
44. Grow up. The word UP with letters growing larger: grow up.
45. Pear. The comma at the end cuts the L from PEARL and leaves a PEAR.
46. Under construction. CONSTRUCTION carries an UNDER-line: under construction.
47. Update. DATE is rotated so it reads upward: UP-date.
48. Backfire. FIRE is mirrored, written backwards: a BACK-fire.
49. House. MOUSE minus its M, plus an H, builds a HOUSE: the mouse moved in.
50. No big deal. BIG DEAL is crossed out: no big deal.
51. Gold. COLD trades its C for a G and strikes GOLD.
52. No strings attached. STRINGS is crossed out (no strings) next to ATTACHED: no strings attached.
53. Pain. RAIN without the R, plus a P, is PAIN: same puddle, worse mood.
54. Empty. The letter names M ('em') and T ('tee') said together sound like EMPTY.
55. Warm. FARM drops the F, gains a W, and gets WARM.
56. Canine. K ('kay') plus 9 ('nine') said together sounds like CANINE.
57. Why not?. The letter Y sounds like WHY, followed by the literal word NOT: why not?
58. Crossword. The word WORD is crossed out: a crossed WORD, i.e. a crossword.
59. See you soon. C sounds like SEE and U sounds like YOU, followed by the literal word SOON.
60. Night. LIGHT swaps its L for an N and the lights go out: NIGHT.
61. Long overdue. LONG sits over DUE: long OVER-due.
62. Beach. PEACH swaps P for B and lands on the BEACH.
63. Big mouth. The word MOUTH is drawn extra big: a big mouth.
64. Downhill. HILL is written reading downward: down-hill.
65. Just in case. JUST is written in CASE: just in case.
66. Year. BEAR trades B for Y and hibernates a whole YEAR.

67. Ship. SHIP flies and sinks: a SPACEship takes off, a SHIPwreck goes down. Think spaceship, shipwreck.
68. Nail. NAIL gets the full manicure: FINGERnail first, NAIL polish on top. Think fingernail, nail polish.
69. Ball. BALL plays all year: SNOWball fights in January, BALLpark hot dogs in July. Think snowball, ballpark.
70. A backward glance. GLANCE is written backwards, so the card is literally taking a backward glance at you.
71. Touchdown. TOUCH runs straight down the page, and in football that is worth six points: touchdown.
72. Two left feet. Both feet point the same way, so this dancer is stuck with two left feet.
73. A broken heart. HEART could not hold itself together after the breakup: broken heart.
74. A friend in need. A FRIEND standing inside NEED is exactly who shows up when you are in trouble.
75. Straw. WARTS backwards is STRAW: much nicer in reverse.
76. Sleep. PEELS read backwards is SLEEP.
