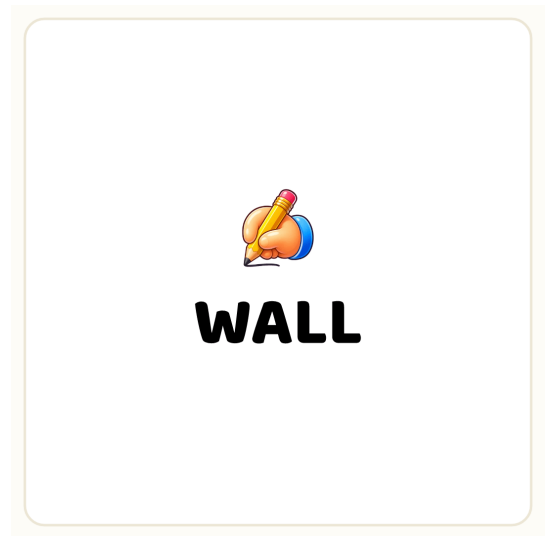

Answer Key

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1. Carnation. CAR plus NATION reads as CARNATION, the flower.
2. Up to speed. The tall arrow gives the direction and the flat arrow gives the TO, bringing you all the way up to speed.
3. Honeycomb. HONEY plus COMB joins into HONEYCOMB.
4. Pet. Take the CAR out of CARPET and a PET is left on the rug.
5. Toothpick. TOOTH plus PICK joined together reads TOOTHPICK.
6. Car. Pull the ROT out of CARROT and drive away in a CAR.
7. Bear hug. BEAR plus HUG reads BEAR HUG, a big tight squeeze.
8. Pump. PUMPKIN minus its KIN leaves the PUMP.
9. Sawdust. SAW plus DUST joined together reads SAWDUST.
10. Try. Remove the PAN from the PANTRY and all you can do is TRY.
11. Backspace. SPACE is written backwards, so the space goes back: backspace.
12. Son. Drain the SEA from SEASON and a SON remains.
13. A fly in the ointment. FLY is planted inside OINTMENT, which reads as a fly in the ointment.
14. Bar. Subtract the GAIN from a BARGAIN and the BAR stays.
15. Cat. Letters 1, 3, and 5 of CHART spell CAT.
16. Unfinished business. The word BUSINESS is cut off before its ending, leaving it unfinished: unfinished business.
17. Moon. Letters 1, 2, 5, and 6 of MOTION rise as the MOON.
18. A skeleton in the closet. SKELETON is hidden inside CLOSET, which reads as a skeleton in the closet.
19. Frog. Letters 1, 2, 3, and 8 of FROSTING hop out as a FROG.
20. Ring. Take the EAR off an EARRING and keep the RING.
21. Too many cooks in the kitchen. A crowd of COOKs is crammed inside KITCHEN: too many cooks in the kitchen.
22. Dog. Letters 1, 2, and 4 of DOUGH fetch a DOG.
23. Safety in numbers. SAFETY sits inside a string of digits, so it is literally safety in numbers.
24. Bee. Letters 1, 3, and 4 of BREEZE buzz out as a BEE.
25. Ache. Shave the MUST off a MUSTACHE and you are left with an ACHE.
26. Star. Letters 1, 2, 3, and 5 of STAIRS shine as a STAR.
27. Fingers crossed. The word FINGERS is crossed out, so the fingers are crossed.
28. Double check. CHECK appears twice, so you check it double: double check.
29. Middle name. The circle marks the middle of the three NAMEs: middle name.
30. Ice in your veins. There is literal ice parked in VEINS, the coldest compliment in sports.
31. A monkey on your back. The monkey is riding on BACK and absolutely refuses to climb

down.

32. The writing on the wall. The hand is writing on WALL, spelling out exactly how this ends.

33. Nine to five. Read the digits and the arrow out loud and you have clocked a full shift: nine to five.

34. Walking on air. The stroller is walking right on top of AIR, which is exactly how good news feels.

35. Pigs in a blanket. Two pigs tucked inside BLANKET, cozy as a party appetizer.

36. A frog in your throat. A frog has moved into THROAT, which is why you keep clearing it.

37. Zero to hero. The digit starts out as nothing and the arrow promotes it: zero to hero.

38. To the moon. Read the arrow as TO THE and the whole card blasts off straight to the moon.

39. See eye to eye. The letter C sounds like SEE, so the two of them finally agree: they see eye to eye.

40. Door to door. One door leads straight to the next, which is exactly how the salesman likes it: door to door.
